Jewish Family Service of San Diego (JFSSD)

- JFSSD provides pro bono [immigration legal services](#) to non-citizens in San Diego County. The nonprofit works to assist as many people as possible within its capacity limitations. Call 858-637-3365 or email immigration@jfssd.org to determine eligibility. Services include:
 - Higher Education Legal Services provides free immigration legal services to students, staff, and faculty at 12 San Diego and Imperial County community and state colleges. Visit the website for a list of colleges served and to determine eligibility: www.jfssd.org/hels.
 - The Immigrant Legal Rights Program provides pro bono immigration legal services to non-citizens in deportation proceedings, including unaccompanied children. This program receives a high number of calls, and there are limitations on the number of cases it can accept. Please contact the program for up-to-date information as its capacity is constantly changing.
 - The Affirmative Immigration Services Program provides free immigration legal services to low-income San Diego County residents seeking immigration benefits for themselves or for their family members living in the U.S.
